

.For your reference, the policies adopted by the Illinois Green Party regarding the selection of delegates is included herein. These policies were approved at an ILGP Membership Meeting held in Crystal Lake, Illinois in October 2007.

#### ADOPTED POLICIES 10/2007

1. The number of Delegates from Illinois to the Green Party Presidential Nominating Convention will be determined by a vote of the Green National Committee.
2. Subsequent to the February 5, 2008 General Primary Election, the Illinois Green Party shall proportionally determine the number of delegates which will be pledged to each presidential candidate based on their percentage of the vote received in the Presidential Preference Primary. The calculation shall be reported out after it is certified by the ILGP Executive Committee. The minimum percentage required to win a delegate in the Illinois Presidential Preference Primary Election is 1 divided by the number of Illinois delegates to the convention. For example, if there are 10 delegates, a candidate must have at least 10% of the primary vote to win a delegate. Candidates exceeding this minimum threshold shall have delegates apportioned using the Method of Equal Proportions.
3. At the 2008 Illinois Green Party State Convention, supporters of candidates winning delegates via the Presidential Preference Primary shall gather in caucuses and produce delegate slates. Each delegate slate shall consist of a number of persons equal to the number of delegates won by the candidate for whom the supporters are caucusing, who shall constitute the Delegates for that candidate; plus a number of persons equal to one half the number of delegates, with fractional parts rounded to the next highest whole number, won by the same candidate, who shall constitute the Alternate Delegates for that candidate; provided that all such Delegates and Alternate Delegates must be members of the Illinois Green Party. No individual may participate in more than one caucus.
4. At the 2008 Green Party Presidential Nominating Convention, Delegates, or Alternate Delegates in the stead of Delegates, at the time of the voting for the Green Party Presidential Nominee, shall be bound to cast first-round ballots for the candidate on whose delegate slate they appeared. Delegates and Alternate Delegates will not be bound for any subsequent rounds of voting, but all such votes must be public and known to the composite Illinois delegation prior to submission.
5. Delegates, or Alternate Delegates in the stead of Delegates, shall not be bound to vote in any manner for votes regarding the approval of the 2008 Green Party of the United States Platform or the selection of the Green Party Vice-Presidential Nominee.
