

Green Party of Louisiana Delegate Plan 2020

Green Party of Louisiana State Convention

The Green Party of Louisiana held its annual state convention on Monday 6/22/2020 via Zoom due to the ongoing pandemic. During our convention we held a presidential preference vote. We held multiple rounds of votes with the final round's result being a victory for Sedinam Moyowasifza-Curry with 60% of votes cast to Howie Hawkins with 40%. No plans were made prior to the state convention to send delegates to the Presidential Nominating Convention by the outgoing Coordinating Committee. During the convention two party members, Morgan Moss, Jr. and John Krause, stepped forward to serve as delegates. The convention unanimously consented to both delegates. There was some confusion at the convention to if the two delegates would cast all 4 votes Louisiana was apportioned or only 2 for the 2 delegates attending. Needing clarification with this question the convention adjourned without further directions for the delegates. The matter was to be taken up at the first meeting of the newly elected Coordinating Committee after clarification of how many votes the delegation could cast at the PNC was received from the GPUS.

Green Party of Louisiana Delegate Plan

The Coordinating Committee of the Louisiana Green Party took up the matter of delegate apportionment at their meeting on 7/5/2020. The GPUS had clarified each of our delegates would receive one vote at the PNC. The Coordinating Committee moved to apportion one vote each to Sedinam Moyowasifza-Curry and Howie Hawkins to proportionally reflect our presidential preference vote held at the state convention. The delegates are only bound to vote for these candidates for the first round and may vote as they please on subsequent ballots. Both delegates, Morgan Moss, Jr. and John Krause, concurred with this delegate plan. Mr. Moss is pledged to Ms. Moyowasifza-Curry and Mr. Krause is pledged to Howie Hawkins.
